

Roll this around a pencil or pen and use it as the dreidel handle.

How to play with a Dreidel

Each player begins with an equal number of game pieces.

At the beginning of each round, every participant puts one game piece into the center "pot". Every player puts one in the pot after every turn.

Each player spins the dreidel once during their turn. Depending on which side is facing up when the dreidel stops spinning, the player either gives or takes game pieces from the pot.

If the dreidel lands on a...

נ (Nun) If the נ is facing up, the player does nothing. The person to the left spins.

ג (Gimel) You get to take the whole pot!

Everyone, including the spinner, puts another ante unit into the pot, and the person to the left spins.

ה (Hey) The player gets half of the pieces in the pot. (If there are an odd number of pieces in the pot, the player takes the half the pot rounded up to the nearest whole number)

ש (Shin) You now have to put another unit into the pot.
